1. **Authenticated Users** – The Provider Portal allows users to view patient radiologic reports and submit scheduling requests. The CIA PACS Client allows the user to view patient radiologic studies and reports from Advanced Medical Imaging. As such, all users within your organization are bound by all appropriate HIPAA compliance standards. Any violation of these standards is grounds for immediate termination of users’ privileges. Additionally, the authorized users agree to not disclose any assigned usernames and passwords to unauthorized personnel and to employ reasonable security means to protect such usernames and passwords. Office personnel should not share the username or password with anyone. All users must login under their own assigned account. The users also agree to notify Colorado Imaging Associates IT staff of any potential violations of security and any unauthorized use of the client software.

2. **Secure Connection** to Colorado Imaging Associates - Access to the Colorado Imaging Associates PACS and the Provider Portal is done through a server at Colorado Imaging Associates. Any detected attempts to access the system without authorization may result in criminal prosecution.

3. **Warranty** - Colorado Imaging Associates makes no warranty which places Colorado Imaging Associates as responsible for the quality of images or the quality of the Internet connection that the user employs. Furthermore, Colorado Imaging Associates makes no warranty as to any effects that the use of the PACS software has on the user's workstation(s). The software is provided for downloading, as is. In no event shall Colorado Imaging Associates be liable for any lost revenue, profit or data, or, for special, indirect, consequential, incidental or punitive damages however caused and regardless of the theory of liability arising out of the use of and or inability to use the software even if Colorado Imaging Associates or its suppliers are notified of the possibility of such damages.
